Simply answer these questions on video

1. Name, title, company, role at or with Intelsat, timeframe
2. In 1964, when the company was founded, every person that worked at Intelsat was obsessed about the future and Intelsat's impact on the future. **What incident, story or episode stands out in your mind that epitomizes Intelsat and its impact on the future?**
 - a. *Can be serious, funny, momentous, historical, awesome, inspiring, achieving the impossible*
 - b. *At the start of your answer, restate the question so the response is a full statement as in:*
 - i. *"I first felt inspired about the future when..."*
 - ii. *"One incident that stands out in my mind is..."*
 - iii. *"A funny story that I remember is..."*
 - iv. *"I knew we were stepping into the future when..."*
3. Today, in 2014, our next generation technology is opening a new frontier and again we are inspired by our impact on the future. **What role do you see Intelsat having in the world, looking ahead, into the future?**

Follow these basic recording guidelines

1. Recording should be off-camera interview style with the subject speaking to someone just off camera instead of directly to the camera (if the speaker prefers to speak directly into the camera, that is fine).
2. White or neutral background is preferred
3. Please have the speaker restate the question so the response is a full statement (e.g., "One incident that stands out in my mind is..." or "One funny story that I remember is...")
4. We may use all or part of your submission, so don't worry about starts and stops
5. Aim for recording to be 90 seconds at most (but if longer to tell your story, that is fine; we may edit to fit)
6. Picture should be a "head and shoulders" shot, off center, as shown.
7. iPhone and iPad videos are fine – be sure to turn the iPhone so you are recording in wide format, as shown.
8. .mov and .wmv formats are preferred; HD 1080i, 1080p, 720p preferred but 480i or 480p are fine
